Department Information

Sun City is the first active, planned adult community in Arizona. The Sun City Fire District was formed on June 16, 1966 and is one of the busiest of the 140+ fire districts in Arizona running over 14,000 each year. The Sun City Fire District is 17.5 square miles and encompasses the communities of Sun City, Youngtown, and Citrus Point. The Sun City Fire & Medical Department is part of the metropolitan Phoenix area automatic aid system of over 20 fire departments including Phoenix, Glendale, Peoria, Tempe, Tolleson, Surprise, El Mirage, Sun City West and Daisy Mountain.

Our three fire stations are geographically distributed throughout our community and house our three ALS Engine companies, one ALS Ladder company and four ALS ambulances. Our Operations Division is currently made up of 63 sworn Firefighters and 24 non-sworn EMS personnel.

The Sun City Fire & Medical Department was granted a CON in early 2016 and on October 3, 2016 our first ambulance was put into service. Today we have four ambulances operating 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Minimum Qualifications

Minimum requirements for these positions are: 18 years of age or older; valid Arizona driver's license; current Arizona State emergency medical technician (EMT) or certified emergency paramedic (CEP) certification; high school diploma or GED equivalent; documentation that provides proof of identity and employability as required by IRCA law.
